Ninety Nine To One put together boxes of items such as good quality clothing for adults and children. We send items such as toiletries, toys, tinned food such as corned beef and beans and fruit, unwanted gifts such as jewellery, perfumes and after shave. We try to send at least three or four boxes every three to four months. The boxes have no weight limit and are distributed amongst the dozen or so villages by church leaders and workers.



Each box is very welcome by the folk in the villages because they contain things that they would never normally purchase because of the cost involved. Simple things like a hair slide, a toy for a child, colouring pens and paper, a new shirt or dress, even a transistor radio or torch. All of these things and more make that little difference to the daily enjoyment of life in what is normally a continual uphill effort just to get by. Please consider supporting this much valued work.
